Key Duties and Responsibilities:

Provides support to the Community Support Worker, to encourage and facilitate the participation of individuals in various programs, both at Venture Training and in the community.

Organizes and implements social, recreational, educational, and vocational activities and programs designed to meet the needs of individual participants. Activities may take place within the organization's facilities or in the community. The Summer Student Support Worker will strive to create a fun and enjoyable atmosphere in order to encourage individual participation in daily activities.

Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates are eligible for summer student employment if they:

- a) are currently enrolled and returning to post-secondary studies;
- b) is a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or a person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;
- c) is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

*Foreign Students are not eligible.

Preference will be given to those with some previous human service/support work experience.
