- Signed declaration of confidentiality
- Signed release of information
- Valid Driver's license and abstract

WHAT IS HOME SHARE NETWORK?

The **Home Share Program** is administrated by the Vernon and District Association for Community Living, a non-profit, community-based organization serving adults with developmental disabilities.

The Home Share Network offers alternatives to staffed residential homes by providing individuals an opportunity to live within their community with non-related families. Support options consist of one of the following:

Family Care Model: The adult lives with a family whether by occupying a bedroom and sharing a communal space or by living in a self-contained suite within the family home.

Modified Family Care Model: The individual has their own apartment or home and Venture Home Share Network lives in an apartment or suite next to a family. The family is responsible for assisting in the development of the individual's independent living skills.

The Program is funded by Community Living British Columbia (CLBC). To join the program contact CLBC (250) 549-5490

Venture Home Share is network contracts with families (including single persons or couples) that are interested in welcoming an individual into their home. It will be your responsibility to create an environment that allows for a healthy and balanced life. You will be required to support an individual to develop and maintain a network of family and friends, find and participate in meaningful activities within the community, support individuals to achieve the fullest possible independence both in the home and the community, and be an active supporter where all people are accepted and respected.
