

What Is Cycle Cycle?

In partnership with the Vernon Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Cycle Cycle is administrated by the Vernon and District Association for Community Living, a nonprofit, community-based organization serving individuals with developmental disabilities. Bicycles that are found throughout Vernon are reported to Cycle Cycle by the community. Program staff and participants retrieve the found bicycles and store them for 90 days at our holding facility. If, after 90 days, the owner has not claimed the bicycle, the individual who reported the bicycle found has the first opportunity to purchase it for \$25.00. If they are not interested, then the bicycle becomes property of Cycle Cycle. At this time, trained employees and participants determine if the bicycle will be sold as is, fixed/repaired, or used for spare parts.

Can I buy a bike? - Absolutely

After bicycles have left the holding area, unclaimed bikes can be purchased directly from Cycle Cycle. The price of each bicycle will vary depending on the condition. Prices range from \$10 to \$70, as is. However, you can request extra work performed on the bicycle for an additional charge, which covers parts and labour. A deposit will be required if you elect to have extra work performed.

Cycle Cycle provides not only valuable training and experience for our participants but also a resource for affordable bicycles in Vernon. All monies raised through sales are returned to the program to assist in operational costs and participant honorariums
